OUR MISSION STATEMENT





Curriculum

St. Patrick School offers a challenging curriculum. Our students consistently score above local, state, and national averages on standardized academic tests. Curriculum plans are revised annually to reflect changes in student learning, instructional resources, and research-based best practices. Continual support, encouragement and praise between parent and child are enhanced by the parents' convenient access to online grades, progress reports and report cards.

With the average class size of 25, it allows for our students to engage in active learning experiences with their teachers and work in small groups with their classmates. Accelerated courses are also available.



Technology

St. Patrick students have daily access to and instruction on modern computer equipment and programs that provide them with the necessary 21st century learning skills. Every academic classroom is equipped with SMART Boards (web-enabled interactive whiteboards). Laptop computer carts and Texas Instruments graphic calculators are also utilized.

Our computer lab contains 26 workstations providing our students with tutorials, keyboarding and technology literacy. Our library and teachers manage and monitor our students' independent reading practice through the Accelerated Reader program.

Extra-Curricula Activities

Students are offered the opportunity to develop further skills in clubs such as:

Through the generosity of parent volunteers, students are given the opportunity to participate in athletics through CYC including basketball (3-8), soccer (preK-8) and volleyball (4-8).



Lunch

The students may participate in the hot lunch program offered daily or they may bring their own lunch. The cafeteria offers many homemade items and full-service salad bar daily.

Before & After Care

An on-site Before and After School Care Program is available for all full-time students. Our staff and aids provide study help for students. The morning hours are 6:45 a.m. until school opens. The afternoon hours are 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m..
